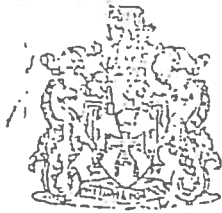

CROSBY CORPORATION ACT, 1968

SEASIDE IMPROVEMENTS

I am writing to inform you that it is anticipated that work will commence on the seaside improvements which were authorised by the above-mentioned Act, on the 3rd February, 1969.

The initial stage of the work will be the tipping of a bank of rubble and other suitable material to form the basis of the new sea wall. Tipping will commence at the end of Mariners Road and will proceed until the bank meets the sea wall of the new dock. Excavation of sand from the site of ~~the boating lake and from elsewhere on the shore will also~~ begin in due course, as will the tipping of suitable material within the line of the bank to form the basis of the new grassed area. Access to the shore for tipping purposes will be limited, for the time being, to Mariners Road and vehicular entrances to the shore from other roads will be obstructed to prevent unauthorised tipping.

In July, the Corporation gave an undertaking that they would give to all owners of property fronting the strip of shore between Great Georges Road and Warrenhouse Road (called "the protected area"), whose names appear in a register kept by the Town Clerk, notice of any town planning applications to be made by the Corporation in respect of the erection of any permanent building or structure on certain parts of the shore. It would now seem appropriate to prepare this Register and I, therefore, send herewith a number of forms. I shall be obliged if you will complete one of these and return it to me as soon as possible so that your name may be entered in the Register. The other copies of the form can be retained by you and used for the registration of any new owner of the property and I shall be very much obliged if you will pass them to the new owner if you sell the property.
